Please submit the following: a completed application, a current official grade transcript, and a typed, double-spaced essay of approximately 500 words.

Essay Topic: What book have you read in high school that has special meaning to you? Why?

Requirements: In order to qualify for a scholarship, the applicant must be enrolled or accepted as a full-time undergraduate student at any institution recognized by the U.S. Department of Education. The scholarships are for undergraduate students only. The student must be a high school senior and must abide by the terms of the application.

Associates, volunteers, and staff of Bossier Federal Credit Union and their immediate family members are not eligible to apply.

Selection: Applications will be collectively sent to the Selection Committee after May 3, 2019. Judging is based on academic achievement (GPA, scholastic honors, and awards), extracurricular activities, work experience, and the written essay. The essay is judged on content, creativity, and clarity. Additionally, grammatical and spelling errors will disqualify your entry. Essays may be published.

Scholarship winners will be notified personally no later than May 17, 2019. Non-winners will not be contacted. Winners are asked to submit a photo for publication at the discretion of the credit union. Awards are presented in the student's name and are presented to the recipients prior to the conclusion of the current school year.
